Our School

Located along the Eagle River in Edwards, Vail Christian High School (VCHS) provides a one-of-a-kind opportunity for Vail Valley's high school students. Since its founding in 1998, VCHS has been devoted to high academic standards and college preparation within a Christian atmosphere based on love, respect, and understanding. Vail Christian High School provides a safe place for students to explore Christian faith and discover their own spirituality. As an independent Christian high school, we're ecumenically diverse, and warmly welcome families and students from all backgrounds.

Curriculum and Programs

At Vail Christian High School, students participate in the Advanced Placement (AP) program beginning in 9th grade. By graduation, the average VCHS graduate will have taken **7 AP** courses from our current **15 AP** offerings. Dual Enrollment (DE) courses are also offered through Colorado Christian University and University of Colorado, Colorado Springs. Project Lead The Way (PLTW) courses (engineering, biomedical and computer science) are also offered and complement their AP counterparts with more experiential, project-based learning.

Spiritual formation is an important component of a VCHS education. Understanding that every student is uniquely designed, we desire that students explore the Christian faith and discover their own faith or spirituality. We also seek to foster a school culture in which love is primary and respect and understanding of others' backgrounds and experiences are non-negotiable. Our community gathers together each week during a chapel service, and Theology courses are an integral part of our school's identity and embody our mission to develop the whole person. Theology offerings include Freshmen Cornerstone/ Heroes, Life and Teachings of Jesus, Ethics/Social Justice and Senior Capstone.

Vail Christian High School is accredited through Cognia and holds memberships with The College Board, National Association for College Admission Counseling, and CESA Member of Council.

COVID-19 Statement

Students utilized Zoom for Synchronous and Asynchronous learning after Spring Break 2020 (March 23, 2020 - May 15, 2020). This was a challenge for several students that live in areas lacking adequate Internet access and/or did not have Internet/technology access.

VCHS Virtual Community was created to provide a portion of every class Monday - Friday as synchronous. Instruction continued as did letter grading. The change came with summative assessments meeting 20% of the student's overall semester grade. Prior to COVID the Final Exams were 20% of the grade. The academic calendar ended one week earlier than what was originally scheduled.

As with many teachers and students/schools, access to Internet/technology and online learning was a challenge.

2020 - 21 School year is in person with the option of hybrid. VCHS will pivot to Synchronous and Asynchronous online learning if needed for the health and safety of students.
